Agenda Items

1. The 2020 Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) program and the Mitigation Project Proposal entitled "Colorado Earthquake Resilience Investigation – Code Review & Rapid Visual Screening Pilot Study." Matt Arsenault will provide an update.

Matt-on July 1, FEMA announced the project was identified for further review. He does not know when additional review will be taking place and thus does not know when it will be awarded.

- 2. Critical Facilities Inventory-Keith Porter (not present); no update
- 3. Seismic Committee of the Structural Engineers Association of Colorado Position statement-Rob-Not certain on how comments would be received, needed to discuss further. Generally, people are supportive. Bottom line is glitch with date of the meeting of membership. Postponed until next week. Will be discussing comments then. Next Thursday there will be a yea/nay vote to adopt or send back to committee. Statement is similar to CEHMC recommendations.
- 4. Website update-Rob will finalize roster and get to Matt/Kyren for inclusion on website.
- 5. Seismic project updates-Oliver no updates on NSHM. Matt updated on Ute Pass-will be running two seismic lines across two parts of the Ute Pass fault. Samples were collected from alluvium and landslide that may be offset by fault; submitted for OSL dating. Oliver-National crustal model to improve ground motions; first model completed of area west of -100 degrees in longitude. Oliver offered to present on topic to CEHMC.
- 6. Kyren can present in Sept. on CO seismic stations
- Cascadia Region EQ Workgroup looking at earthquake insurance in west, could share concerns
 from insurance commissioners and issues getting earthquake insurance (Sean). FEMA-funded
 project and data will available to public.
- 8. "12th National Conference on EQ Engineering" June 27-Jul 1, 2022 in Salt Lake City; Sean is a cochair; call for papers in early Aug.
