COLORADO EARTHQUAKE HAZARD MITIGATION COUNCIL

12:00 to 2:00 PM, November 17, 2022

- 1. In attendance: Michael Haughey, Rob Jackson, Robin McGuire, Sean McGowan, Kyren Bogolub, Steven Boand, Matt Morgan, Oliver Boyd, Dee Stevens, Will Levandowski
- 2. Additions to agenda: Rob mentioned that a M2.5 earthquake occurred earlier in the day northwest of Grand Junction.
- 3. Approval of minutes from the September 15, 2022, meeting, Approved and seconded.
- 4. Matthew Morgan is the new Director of the Colorado Geological Survey and the Colorado State Geologist. He is stepping down as CEHMC Co-chair but will remain a member of CEHMC. Kyren Bogolub was nominated and seconded to be the next Co-chair. A formal vote will be taken by e-mail before the next meeting.
- 5. The 2020 Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) program and the Mitigation Project Proposal entitled "Colorado Earthquake Resilience Investigation Code Review & Rapid Visual Screening Pilot Study." There are two elements to the project. Element 1 is a statewide examination of building codes applied to all K-12 public schools. Element 2 encompasses a pilot study of up to six critical infrastructure buildings using FEMA 154. The Las Animas County / City of Trinidad seismic area is to be examined as an Element 2 study site. Working group met May 24, June 21, August 16 and September 20. Code review meetings have occurred on July 25, August 22, September 26 and October 24. Rob Jackson gave a code presentation at the August 22 meeting. Jim Harris and Keith Porter presented at the 9/26 meeting in support of increased seismic design requirements when evaluated in terms of cost/benefit ratio.

Michael Haughey volunteered to join the BRIC code group (Element 1). Rob will recommend Michael to attend the next meeting. So far the group has been selected and managed by the State. Nov & Dec 26 code meetings cancelled due to holidays. The next code group meeting will be Dec 12, 11:00 AM.
